**NOTES:** The purpose of this infographic is to show the evolution of Superman's "S" Shield since his debut in 1938. It was deemed just as important to show how stable the design was through certain periods as it was to show how much it changed through others. The omission of certain years was a decision based on the design of the "S" Shield for that year being virtually the same as the year before and/or after it.

National Periodical Publications (now known as "DC Comics") registered the trademark for Superman's "S" Shield in 1945.
